## Reed Farrel Coleman

Called a hard-boiled poet by NPR's Maureen Corrigan, Reed Farrel Coleman is the New York Times bestselling author of thirty-one novels including six in Robert B. Parker's Jesse Stone series. He is a four-time recipient of the Shamus Award for Best PI Novel of the Year, and a four-time Edgar Award nominee in three different categories. Reed has also received the Scribe, Audie, Macavity, Barry, and Anthony Awards. He is the former Executive VP of Mystery Writers of America and a former adjunct instructor at Hofstra University. His new Blackstone novel *Sleepless City* will be published in the fall of 2022. Reed lives with his wife on Long Island.

## Matt Goldman

Matt Goldman is a New York Times Bestselling author and Emmy Award winning television writer. He has been nominated for a Writers Guild Award, the Shamus Award, and the Nero Award. Matt's television writing credits include *Seinfeld*, *Ellen*, *The New Adventures of Old Christine*, and *Dirk Gently's Holistic Detective Agency*. Matt lives in Minneapolis with his wife, two dogs, and two cats.



## Charles Salzberg

Charles Salzberg is a former magazine journalist, whose work has appeared in New York magazine, Esquire, GQ, Redbook, and The New York Times, and a nonfiction book writer (*From Set Shot to Slam Dunk*, an Oral History of the NBA and *Soupy Sez: My Zany Life and Times*). He's been twice nominated for the Shamus Award for *Swann's Last Song*, the first in the series, and *Second Story Man* (also winner of the Beverly Hills Book Award). *Devil in the Hole* was named one of the Best Crime Novels of 2013 by Suspense magazine. His latest novel is *Canary in the Coal Mine*. He teaches writing in New York City, is a Founding Member of New York Writers Workshop, formerly served on the Mystery Writers of America-NY, and is on the board of PrisonWrites.

## Michael Wiley

Michael Wiley is the Shamus Award winning writer of the Sam Kelson mysteries (*Trouble in Mind*, *Lucky Bones*, *Head Case*), the Joe Kozmarski mysteries (*The Last Striptease*, *The Bad Kitty Lounge*, *A Bad Night's Sleep*), the Daniel Turner thrillers (*Blue Avenue*, *Second Skin*, *Black Hammock*), and the Franky Dast thrillers (*Monument Road* and the forthcoming *Sugar Hill*). He also writes critical books (*Romantic Geography* and *Romantic Migrations*), critical essays, and book reviews. He is a former director on the national board of the Mystery Writers of America. Michael grew up in Chicago and lived and worked in the neighborhoods where he sets his Kelson and Kozmarski mysteries. He teaches at the University of North Florida in Jacksonville, the setting of the Daniel Turner and Franky Dast books.
